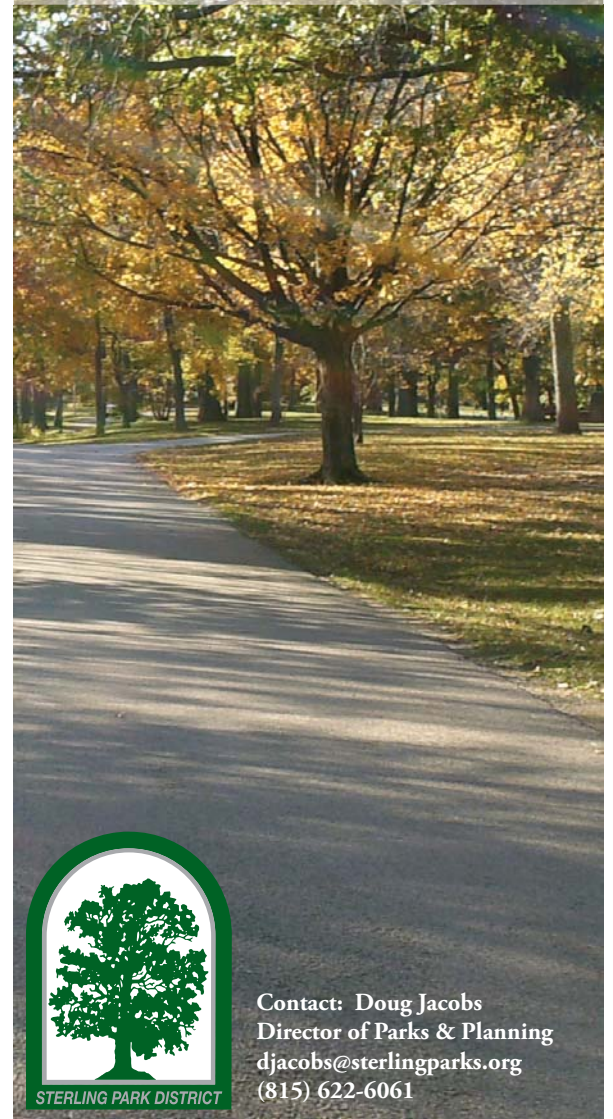

Thank you for your interest in the Sterling Park District Tree & Park Bench Donation Program. What better tribute could one make than a memorial that will benefit many for years to come? Benches can be installed from April through November. Trees are planted twice yearly. The deadline for spring planting requests is April 1. The deadline for fall planting requests is September 1.

Donors are allowed to:

- Choose the location
- Choose a specific tree or type of bench
- Purchase a bronze plaque and inscription to identify the memorial

The Sterling Park District will:

- Assist donors with their bench or tree choice and site selection
- Help host a ceremony for the dedication of the tree or bench
- Provide care and maintenance of the tree or bench
- Replace/repair the tree or bench, if necessary, at no cost to the donor

BENCH OPTIONS

Wood Slat Bench

Available options include length, building material, flat or with back rest and with or without armrests. Available locations are parks, Emerald Hill Golf Course and along the S.M.A.R.T. Trail.



Rolled Metal Bench

Available options include length, pattern, color, flat or with back rest and with or without armrests. Available locations are Westwood, parks and along the S.M.A.R.T. Trail.

TREE OPTIONS

American Linden

This is a stately, tall tree, growing to more than 100 feet. It has gray to brown bark and large, toothed, heart-shaped, deciduous leaves. The leaves are dark green above and pale beneath, turning yellow or yellow-green in the fall.

Canadian Hemlock

A handsome and graceful evergreen. Can grow up to 40' - 70'.

Concolor Fir

Light-colored bark and silver blue-green needles. Matures at 50' in home landscape.

Eastern Redbud

Rosy pink flowers appear in April. Reddish-purple leaves change to dark green, then to yellow. Grows to 20' to 30', 30' spread.

Eastern White Pine

A hardy, valuable tree. Clustered soft blue-green needles. Ideal screen or windbreak. Grows 50'- 80' with a 20-40' spread.

Flowering Crab

Red-budded, with dark pinkish red flowers and red-purple fruit. It grows as high as 20 feet, with a spread up to 15 feet.

Red Oak

Bristle-tipped leaves turn red in the fall. Grows as much as two feet a year for 10 years. Grows to 60' to 75', 45' spread.

Shagbark Hickory

Provide excellent fall foliage color. They derive their name from the exfoliating bark they bear.

Sugar Maple

Medium to dark-green leaves turn yellow, burnt orange or red in fall. Grows to 60' to 75', 40'-50' spread.

White Oak

An impressive tree with a stately, broad-rounded form. Dark green leaves in the summer, turn showy red in the fall. Slow to moderate growth rate. Grows 50'-80', with an equal spread.
